All circular polarizing filters of the new filter line are provided with the proven MRC coating with 16x layer and thus enable high-contrast and color-neutral images.

The use of polarizing filters reduces annoying reflections and at the same time increases the color saturation in the image. In addition, the use of the filter keeps the front lens free of dirt such as dust, sand, fingerprints or scratches.

With the Basic filter line, B+W Filter is changing its packaging from plastic boxes to sustainable cotton bags with a practical drawstring. The Basic circular polarizing filter is available in sizes \emptyset 37 mm to \emptyset 105 mm and is suitable for wide-angle to telephoto lenses.
